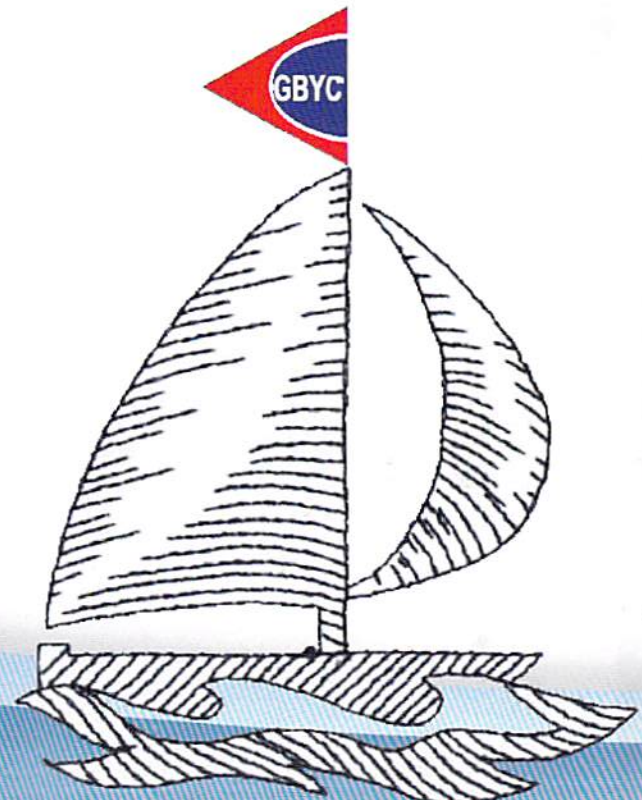
Memberships: Full (Sailboat) members cast ballots at Annual General & Membership meetings.

Plus everyone 13% HST



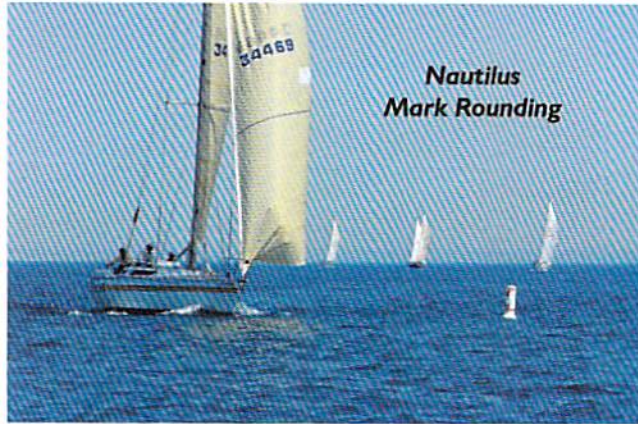

- Do not leave personal belongings for others to clean up

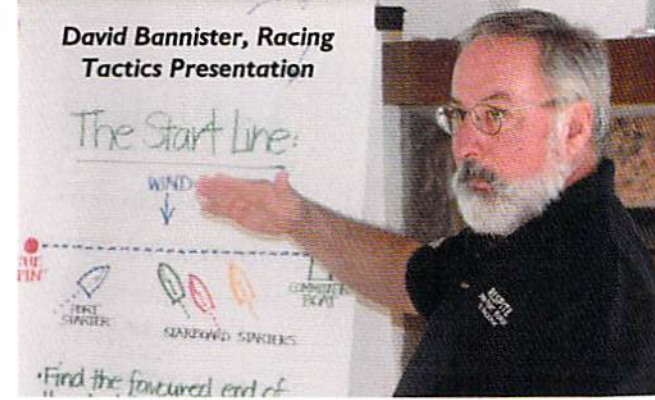
If you are the last to leave, ensure the Clubhouse is locked and that your keys are safe and available only to persons authorized to use the Clubhouse.

Liquor is not to be stored on the premises or sold without a special event license
Pets, and unaccompanied children under 12, are not allowed in the Clubhouse

Clubhouse Rules:

- The Clubhouse is to be left in good condition and clean after each use. All trash must be placed in trash containers.
- All equipment, furniture, etc., in the Clubhouse cannot be removed or borrowed
- Disposable equipment and supplies in the Clubhouse are not for private parties
- Codes for the doors and washrooms access keyboards should not be revealed to non members or guests
- Likewise passwords and user names are not to be distributed beyond members. Child, upstairs TV watching must be supervised using the Club's computer/printer/TV

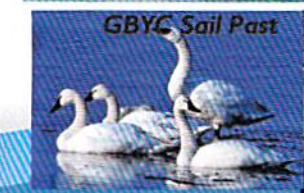
